Moreover, the Regions reflected above are the political regional zoning used by the NWPC-DOLE which are different from the regional zoning adopted by the Bureau of Internal Revenue (BIR). Hence, a particular Wage Order can be used as reference by two or more regions as adopted by the BIR (e.g. WO NCR-17 for BIR Regions 6, 7 and 8) or a particular BIR Regional Office can refer to more than one Wage Order (e.g. BIR Region 7 may refer to WO No. NCR-17 or WO No. IVA-15).
